After a little over a year fostering her, we were eagerly awaiting our adoption court date. It can take many months to finally get your adoption day. We were supposed to be on a plane headed for Africa and needed to adopt Jubiley before we left. Our incredible ad litem was able to get a court date to request an expedited adoption day. The judge was amazing. He heard our story and said he would do whatever it took to get this baby girl adopted. Our ad litem said in 30 years he had never seen this happen. In the spring of 2019, we adopted Jubiley.
